Note:

\*Senior-year (Advanced Standing II) admission is only available to local students.

In addition to the General Entrance Requirements, individual degrees/majors may require specific subject backgrounds. Please refer to the respective programme webpages for details of programme-specific requirements.

Final-year student or graduate of an AD/HD programme recognized by CityUHK are eligible to apply for senior-year (Advanced Standing II) admission.

No CGPA or overall mark requirements are set for the purpose of application for senior-year (Advanced standing II) admission. However, as competition for admission is keen, accepted applicants are normally expected to have completed an AD/HD with a CGPA 3.0 or an equivalent overall mark, or a credit award. Individual programmes may set higher requirements.

For final-year AD/HD students, offers of admission will be conditional upon the successful attainment of an AD/HD award, accompanied by a specified CGPA, overall mark or award classification if deemed appropriate.

# ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS

## Admission to Year 1

Applicants holding a school-leaving qualification or a partially completed sub-degree qualification may apply for admission to Year 1 in a Bachelor's degree programme. Depending on the programme, students are either admitted directly to a major in their first year or admitted to a college/school/department with an undeclared major (enter a major after one year of study).

## Admission with Advanced Standing I

Students admitted to the University with Advanced Standing I take fewer credits units for graduation (minimum 90 credit units instead of 120 credit units for a four-year degree curriculum, depending on majors).

## Admission with Advanced Standing II (Senior Year)

Senior-year entrants admitted with Advanced Standing II take fewer credits units for graduation (minimum 60 credit units instead of 120 credit units for a four-year degree curriculum, depending on majors).

Students admitted with Advanced standing will not be entitled to further credit transfer on the basis of qualifications attained prior to their admission to the University. Instead, students may be granted exemption from specific courses based on prior study. Credit units are not earned for exempted courses.

AD/HD graduates who do not receive a senior-year (Advanced Standing II) place may be considered for Advanced Standing I admission. It is not necessary for applicants to indicate their preference at the time of application. The offer of Advanced Standing I or Advanced Standing II entry is decided by the programme-offering unit.

For programmes without senior year (Advanced Standing II) admissions, applicants may consider submitting the Advanced Standing I admission applications, if available, instead.

### STEP 1

#### Apply

### STEP 2

#### Submit your Application

- Complete the online application
- Upload supporting documents
- Pay application fee (HKD200 per programme)
- Attend interview, if any

### STEP 3

#### Check Application Results

Check your email and online application account regularly

### STEP 4

#### Offer Acceptance

Pay acceptance fee (HKD5,000)

### STEP 5

#### Fulfilment of Offer Conditions

(for applicants who receive conditional offers)

Supply the documentation certifying the fulfilment of conditions

### STEP 6

#### Documents for Verification

Present the ORIGINAL certificate/ official certification if requested

### STEP 7

#### Enrolment / Orientation

- Complete student enrolment and join orientation activities in August
- Commence study for 2025 entry
