Racing Laboratory

The Hong Kong Jockey Club Racing Laboratory, established in 1970, is a world-class equine drug testing facility that conducts doping control analysis of horse biological samples and upholds the integrity of racing and equestrian sports. With a dedicated workforce committed to values of integrity, quality, impartiality, professionalism and efficiency, the laboratory provides highest standard of analytical and advisory services in doping control.

During the lab visit, students will have the opportunity to acquire knowledge regarding the doping control analyses in horse racing. They will gain insights into the collection and analysis of biological samples from horses, as well as familiarize themselves with an array of analytical techniques and instruments employed in the laboratory's operations.

Wagering Products
