The Delegation of the Guangdong High People's Court Visited the School of Law and the Centre for Judicial Education and Research, City University of Hong Kong

Led by **Justice GONG Jiali**, President of the Guangdong High People's Court, the delegation of the Guangdong High People's Court visited the School of Law and CJER, City University of Hong Kong on 22nd February 2019.
