Professor Chelon Colin NG, who is a CityU BMS alumni, is Adjunct Professor at CityU Department of Public and International Affairs. Prof. Ng has expertise in public affairs, Chinese politics, entrepreneurship, biomedical engineering, technology and innovation, accounting, finance, strategy, economics, media and communication, real estate. He founded Greater Bay Biotechnology (GBBT) which focuses on transdermal cell and drug delivery technology with wide applications including the treatment of diseases (e.g. diabetes, cancer) and anti-aging and has won numerous awards, including awarded HK Tech 300 Seed and Angel Funds, Award of the 1st HK Tech 300 National Start-up Competition, Hong Kong Science and Technology Park (HKSTP) Ideation, HKSAR Government Innovation and Technology Fund's Technology Start-up Support Scheme for Universities (TSSSU), First Prize in Entrepreneurship in the 8th Hong Kong University Student Innovation and Entrepreneurship Competition, Ministry of Industry and Information Technology (MIIT) 1st Light of Innovation Award (the only awardee in HK, Macao, Taiwan region).
