## Dr. Lam Kwok Pun Memorial Badminton Awards

### Regulations

With effect from academic year 2012/13, Mr. L.O. Leung has newly injected HK\$150,000 to the University and the donation fund together with the matching grant<sup>1</sup> will be used to recognize the achievement of badminton team and student athletes. The following regulations shall apply as of 2015/16 :

1. *There shall be two **Team Awards** in recognition of the outstanding achievement of the CityU Men's and Women's Badminton Teams in inter-collegiate competitions. The value of the awards shall depend on the results as achieved by the Badminton Teams in the year:*

<i>Champion</i>	<i>:</i>	<i>HK\$10,000</i>
<i>Second</i>	<i>:</i>	<i>HK\$8,000</i>
<i>Third</i>	<i>:</i>	<i>HK\$5,000</i>
2. *There shall be two **Athlete Awards** in the amount of HK\$5,000@ per annum, with one for a male student and the other for a female student, who met the following criteria.*
  - i. *demonstrated good sports performance and achievements in local or international competitions; and*
  - ii. *have proven leadership and sportsmanship in the CityU badminton team; and*
  - iii. *obtained satisfactory academic performance in a UGC-funded programme.*
3. *The nominations for the Team Awards and the Athlete Awards shall be made by the coaches of CityU Sports Team and the winners of the Athlete Awards will be selected by a selection panel.*
4. *The Awards shall be presented at the annual CityU Sports Team Ceremony cum Annual Gathering.*

### Remarks:

1. *The matching grant (if any) shall support the Badminton Awards for local students only.*
2. *With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the Community Relations Committee of the University Council has recommended that each award recipient is expected to make an annual donation of at least HK\$200 to City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes, whether they are donated by external donors or contributed by University funding, with effect from February 2008.*
