Outstanding Athletes Entrance Scholarships for International & Regional Levels

(previously named as Sports Entrance Scholarships)

Regulations

Number and Value of the Awards

International Level: A maximum of 5 awards, HK\$40,000@ per annum.

Regional Level: A maximum of 10 awards, HK\$20,000@ per annum.

Tenure

The Scholarship is tenable for two to four years depending on the duration of the registered UGC undergraduate / UGC associate degree programme of the students.

Requirement for Scholarship Renewal

The renewal of Scholarship shall be subject to:

- 1. students' continued satisfactory academic performance with a Cumulative GPA of 2.5 by the end of Semester B each year; and*
- 2. students' continued satisfactory sports performance and team contribution as determined by the Physical Education Section.(see appendix A for details)*

Terms and Conditions

- 1. The award shall be paid by two equal instalments by crediting to students' university account to offset partial tuition fee directly. The first instalment is payable in the middle of Semester A while the second is payable in the end of Semester B. Nevertheless, Physical Education Section may reserve the right to withhold the payment for Semester B if student does not make satisfactory sports performance and team contribution in the academic year.*
- 2. Eligible applicants for the scholarships shall be full-time undergraduate freshmen who have been admitted to CityU via the University's Student Athlete Admission Scheme.*
- 3. The Scholarship may be suspended for any period when*
 - i) the student is absent from the University, such as enrolling in a year-long job placement scheme or other interruption; or*
 - ii) the student is absent/ has withdrawn/ has been removed from University's sports teams.*
- 4. The sports achievement / performance of the candidates will be recognized in the recent one year (i.e. 1 Sep 14 – 30 Aug 15).*
- 5. Nominations shall be made by the coaches of CityU Sports Team and the winners of the awards will be selected by a Selection Panel to be chaired by the Associate Director (Physical Education) of Student Development Services.*

Remark:

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the Community Relations Committee of the University Council has recommended that each award recipient is expected to make an annual donation of at least HK\$200 to City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes, whether they are donated by external donors or contributed by University funding, with effect from February 2008.
