Prof. Paul K. Chu Badminton Awards

Regulations

Prof. Paul K. Chu has kindly donated HK\$30,000 to the University to recognize the achievements of the badminton team and student athletes of CityU for three consecutive years, i.e. 2015/16 to 2017/18 under the following regulations:

1. *There shall be two types of awards, namely **Team Awards** and **Athlete Awards**. Nevertheless, either Team Awards or Athlete Awards will be granted per annum.*
2. *For **Team Awards**, there shall be two awards in the amount of HK\$5,000@ in recognition of the outstanding achievement of the CityU Men's and Women's Badminton Teams in inter-collegiate competitions.*
3. *For **Athlete Awards**, there shall be two awards in the amount of HK\$5,000@, with one for a male student and the other for a female student who have met the following criteria :*
 - i. *demonstrated good sports performance and achievements in local or international competitions; and*
 - ii. *proven leadership and sportsmanship in the CityU badminton team; and*
 - iii. *obtained satisfactory academic performance with CGPA 2.0 or above in a CityU programme.*
4. *The nominations for the Team Awards/Athlete Awards shall be made by the coach(es) of Badminton Team and the winners of the Athlete Awards will be selected by a selection panel.*
5. *The Awards shall be presented at the CityU Sports Team Annual Prize Presentation Ceremony cum Team Gathering.*

Remarks:

1. *The donation shall support the Badminton Awards for full-time students only.*
2. *With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the Community Relations Committee of the University Council has recommended that each award recipient is expected to make an annual donation of at least HK\$200 to City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes, whether they are donated by external donors or contributed by University funding, with effect from February 2008.*
