Pang Hon Chiu Li Yuk Fong Basketball and Soccer Awards

Regulations

Pang Hon Chiu Li Yuk Fong Basketball and Soccer Awards shall be offered to players of the Basketball and Soccer Teams of City University of Hong Kong in the academic year 2015-16 under the following regulations:

- 1. The Awards shall be known as "Pang Hon Chiu Li Yuk Fong Basketball and Soccer Awards".
- 2. There shall be a maximum of HK\$40,000 for "Team Awards" and "Individual Awards" for each sport, namely basketball and soccer, as follows:

Team Award (capped at HK\$30,000)		
Results in Inter-Collegiate Competitions	Amount (HK\$)	No. of Awards for each sport
Champion	15,000	Max. 2 teams* for each sport
1 st runner-up	10,000	Max. 2 teams* for each sport
2 nd runner-up	5,000	Max. 2 teams* for each sport
Individual Awards (capped at HK\$10,000)		
Most Valuable Players (MVP)	5,000	Max. 2 players [#] for each sport

*Men's team and women's team [#]One male MVP and one female MVP

In case the scholarships are not fully distributed in the current academic year, the remaining sum will be carried forward for granting next year.

- 3. Nomination(s) shall be made by the coaches of CityU Sports Teams, and winners of the awards shall be selected by Selection Panel chaired by the Associate Director (Physical Education) of Student Development Services by April of each year.
- 4. Confirmation will be made with Physical Education Section of Student Development Services in June/July on whether or not the Awards will be continued for the following academic year.

Remark:

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the Community Relations Committee of the University Council has recommended that each award recipient is expected to make an annual donation of at least HK\$200 to City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes, whether they are donated by external donors or contributed by University funding, with effect from February 2008.
