APPLICATION PROCEDURES

ELIGIBILITY

- Full-time UGC-funded undergraduate students;
- Student leaders from a relevant academic and/or administrative unit of the University or relevant government organisations/ Non-governmental Organisations (NGOs)/ charitable organisations in the community in 2024/25;
- Have track records for serving the University and/or the community in 2024/25;
- Showed the **biggest** improvement in GPA: Sem B vs Sem A in 2024/25 (at least > 0.1);
- Achieved a CGPA ≥ 2.5 by the end of Sem B 2024/25.

Submit your application & an Essay in English (700 words) on "What have you done or achieved to deserve this award?" via the online application system (see QR code) no later than **12:00 noon**, **9 June, 2025 (Monday)**. Late or incomplete applications will **not** be considered.

Academic Improvement Awards for Student Leaders 學生領袖成績進步獎

Regulations

The award scheme has been established with the aims to:

- encourage students who make contributions and efforts to serve the University or the community at large to strive for further improvement in their academic studies;
- promote the caring and giving culture in the University community.

The implementation in the 2024/25 academic year will be as follows:

- 1. The Awards shall be known as the "Academic Improvement Awards for Student Leaders" (學生領袖成績進步獎).
- 2. There shall be a maximum of TEN awards per annum in the amount of HK\$5,000 each.
- 3. The Awards shall be offered to full-time UGC-funded undergraduate students who:
 - a) have provided satisfactory track records on their contribution and services for serving the University and/or the community in the 2024/25 academic year;
 - b) have obtained a citation detailing the role of being student leaders from a relevant academic and/or administrative unit of the University or relevant government organisations/ Non-governmental Organisations (NGOs)/ charitable organisations in the community in the 2024/25 academic year;
 - c) have shown the biggest improvement as reflected in their GPA in Semester B as compared with the GPA in Semester A in the 2024/25 academic year; and such an improvement as reflected should be >0.1; and
 - d) have achieved a CGPA 2.5 or above by the end of Semester B in the 2024/25 academic year.

Remark:

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the University encourages each award recipient to make an annual donation of HK\$200 or more to the City University of Hong Kong for student support via the CityUHK Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes since February 2008.
